All applicants must meet in person with a Sandburg radiologic technology/CT advisor prior to applying to the program. Make an appointment early in the process, and complete steps 1-3 before to making an appointment with program advisor.

STEP 1

- If you've never attended Sandburg, complete an application for general admission to the college, and if desired, apply for financial aid. Access more info at sandburg.edu/discover-sandburg/welcome/how-to-apply.

STEP 2

- Send an official high school transcript or equivalent and any appropriate post-secondary educational institutions transcripts to the registrar at transcripts@sandburg.edu.

All applicants must meet the following admission criteria for selection review:

STEP 6

- Graduate from an ARRT-approved radiography program with a 2.5 or higher cumulative G.P.A. on a 4.0 scale.

STEP 7

- Provide evidence of active registration with the ARRT or registry-eligible status.

Meeting all eligibility criteria for selection doesn't guarantee admission to the CT program. Only those applicants who submit the online program application by the deadline date and who've met all eligibility and admission requirements will be considered. If more qualified applicants apply than the number of available seats, selection will be made according to application submission date. If applicants submitted applications on the same date, the applicant's GPA will determine selection order.
